First of all I want to let you know that I am a big supporter of your work regarding vaccination and freedom of choice.

Unfortunately, as an employee of the WA health department, I am not allow to share my opinion more publicly, so please forgive me if I have chosen to remain anonymous (fake name and email) in fear of losing my job.

I believe this Tuesday the first page of the Western Australian newspaper portrayed the story of a child who possibly suffered some bad effect from contracting the flu, urging everybody to vaccinate against it.

But the info I just got tell a different story.

I confidentially and unofficially got the following information from a high rank health care practitioner working at the Fiona Stanley Hospital.

This person told me that, due to a high level of employees complain about experiencing mild to more severe adverse reaction from the flu vaccine and with a higher than expected rate of people hospitalized for severe anaphylactic reaction shortly after receiving the shot, they decided, again unofficially, to stop pushing flu vaccination on their employees.
